- (a) whether the Government has set any targets to increase exports in certain countries;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the targets set for export during the financial year 2009-10 and achievements made in this regard so far country-wise and productwise;
- (c) the details regarding value of exports made from SEZs and non-SEZs during the last one year;
- (d) whether any assessment has been made regarding export potential of the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof alongwith the corrective measures being taken to tackle the bottlenecks being faced by exporters?

- (a) & (b): Despite steep decline in export growth since October, 2008 in the wake of unprecedented global economic slowdown, a target of US\$ 200 billion has been set for 2010-2011 for merchandise exports. Presently, Country-wise export details for the period 2009-10 are not available.
- (c): Figures of Merchandise exports of India and those from SEZs for the period 2008-09 are given below:
