(a) There are Twenty Four (24) space research centres in the country as on date. The list showing the details, location wise, is given in Annexure-1.

(b) No, Madam. At present there are no plans to set up new space research centres in the country.

(e) A plan outlay of Rs.39,750/- crore has been proposed for the space research by the Department of Space/ Indian Space Research Organisation in the 12th Five Year Plan, as compared to an expenditure of `15,195/- crore in the 11th Five Year Plan.
