- (b) if so, the details thereof, and

Answer

MINISTER OF NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY (DR. FAROOQ ABDULLAH)

- (a)&(b): Yes, Madam. M/s Sulabh International Academy of Environment Sanitation and Public Health, New Delhi has developed the technology for generating biogas and power through human excreta under a research and development project sponsored by the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy. Four biogas based power plants one 20 KVA and two 10 KVA each at Shirdi and one 5.5 KVA at Sulabh International Office Complex, New Delhi using human excreta have been installed by M/s Sulabh International.
- (c): Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has been implementing programme on generation of biogas and power from organic wastes including human excreta.
