(a)&(b): The Ministry has been utilising the national clean energy funds for installations of off-grid solar applications such as home lights and small capacity SPV systems, stand-alone SPV power plants and solar water pumping systems and solar water heating systems in the country under the first phase of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Solar Mission (JNNSM). Under the second Phase of the Mission, national clean energy funds are proposed to be utilised for the grid and off-grid solar applications depending on the availability of funds and sanctions.
