- (a) & (b): Yes Madam, the details of the case handed over to the National Investigation Agency for investigation including inter-State terrorism during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise including naxal affected State is at ANNEXURE-I enclosed.
- (c): The National Investigation Agency has filed charge sheet in 25 cases. Out of these 25 cases, in 23 cases trials are taking place in Court. 02 accused persons have been convicted in two cases.
