IMPACT OF NATURAL CALAMITIES

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether several parts of the country were hit by natural calamities including cyclone 'Nilam' recently;
- (b) if so, the details of loss of lives and damage to properties and crops reported during the current year, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has sent any Central team to assess the situation in the affected States;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the assessment made thereon, State-wise; and
- (e) the details of financial assistance provided by the Government to the affected States, State-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN)

(a) & (b): Yes Madam. The details of loss of lives, damage to property and crops as reported by the States/ Union Territories affected by natural calamities like to flash floods/ floods/ landslides/ cloudburst, Cyclone including cyclone 'Nilam' etc. during the current year 2012 is given at Annexure-I.

(c) & (d) The States of Assam, Kerala, Sikkim and Uttarakhand have submitted memoranda for additional central assistance from the National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF) for supplementing their relief efforts. The State-wise details of the assistance sought, visit of the Central Teams, status of team's reports and assistance approved, are at Annexure-II.

(e) A statement showing State-wise allocation and releases of funds from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF)/ NDRF to the States during 2012-13 is given at Annexure-III.
