To ensure greater efficiency, cost effectiveness and better delivery for kerosene, Domestic LPG and fertilisers, the Government has decided to move towards direct transfer of cash subsidy to people living below poverty line in a phased manner. The Government has launched pilot projects in Alwar, Rajasthan and Mysore, Karnataka in respect of direct transfer of cash subsidy for Kerosene and Domestic LPG, respectively.
