Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has proposed to construct two new high speed access controlled expressways connecting Delhi with Jaipur and Chandigarh;
- (b) if so, the details and present status thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the construction of these expressways is likely to be started?

Answer

- (a) & (b) Yes Madam; the two corridors, Delhi – Jaipur & Delhi – Chandigarh are identified for development of access controlled expressways under National Highway Development Project (NHDP) Phase-VI. Both are in stage of pre-feasibility stage;
- (c) Time frame can not be ascertained at this stage.
