- (a) whether the Government proposes to widen the Ranchi Giridih National Highway stretch;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the time-frame in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government also proposes to renovate the monuments on the said stretch; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI SARVEY SATHYANARAYANA)

(a) to(d) Ministry of Road Transport & Highways is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways in the country. Giridih is connected with Ranchi through part of NH-33 (Ranchi-Hazaribagh section), NH-100 (Hazaribagh-Bagodar section), NH-2 (Bagodar-Dumri Section) and NH-114A (Dumri-Giridih section). Work of 4-laning in Ranchi-Hazaribagh section and 2-laning in Hazaribagh-Bagodar section has been taken up. 4-laning in Bagodar-Dumri Section has already been completed. Dumri-Giridih section has recently been declared as National Highway No 114-A.
