STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 123 FOR 27TH NOVEMBER, 2009

- (a)&(b): There is no single international standard governing medical research, although several inter governmental and international agencies have formulated various guidelines for conduct of research. India has put in place various guidelines and regulations conforming to major guidelines for the conduct of medical research studies
- (c): There are 27 institutes of the Indian Council of Medical Research. The statewise list is at Annexure 1 and major achievements is at Annexure 2.
- (d): Yes Sir, upgradation of the ICMR Institutes and their laboratories is a continuous and ongoing process and most centres have State of the Art laboratories. There is no centre of ICMR at Kasauli
- (e): An amount of Rs 184.7 crores has been spent for upgradation of facilities and equipment in ICMR institutes in the eleventh plan till October, 2009.
