- (b) Govt. of India has received a complaint from Shri Ganesh Rao Dudhgaonkar, Member of Parliament, Lok Sabha on 16th September, 2009 alleging negligence on the part of doctors of Civil Hospital, Parbani in treating Shri Ganapati Raut, a suspected case of Swine Flu, who died on 16th September, 2009. The matter has been taken up with Government of Maharashtra.
- (c) & (d): No such instructions have been issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.
