SHORTAGE OF QUALIFIED IT PROFESSIONALS

**Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is a shortage of Information Technology professionals in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the corrective measures taken by the Government in this regard?

**Answer**

(a) and (b): As per National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM); the country currently has sufficient talent (in terms of numbers) to meet existing demand. The industry has a total workforce of nearly 2.8 million as of 2012 as against an average generation of about 4 million graduates / post graduates in the country.
