## Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to implement the new Pharmaceutical Policy;
- (b) if so, the reasons for delay in approving the said policy;
- (c) the names of 348 essential medicines that are proposed to bring under the above policy;
- (d) the present price of each of the above 348 drugs; and
- (e) the estimated price of each of the above 348 drugs once the said policy is notified?

## **Answer**

(a)and(b): The Department of Pharmaceuticals had prepared a draft National Pharmaceutical Pricing Policy, 2011 (NPPP-2011) based on the criteria of essentiality as per the medicines as under National List of Essential Medicines-2011 (348 drugs with specified dosage and strengths), as stipulated by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare which was placed before the Group of Ministers(GoM). Based on the recommendations of the GoM, National Pharmaceuticals Pricing Policy~2012(NPPP-2012) was formulated and placed before the Cabinet. The Cabinet considered NPPP-2012 in its meeting held on 22.11,2012 and approved the same with certain modifications. Further action to notify NPPP-2012 has been undertaken.

(c) to (e): In view of reply to (a) & (b) above, as NPPP-2012 has not yet been notified, does not arise.
