to (c):-Guidelines have been issued to Banks to launch campaign to open atleast one bank account for each family, subject to fulfillment of Know Your Customer (KYC) norms prescribed by Reserve Bank of India (RBI), which also includes the letter issued by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) as an `Officially Valid Document` for the purpose of KYC for opening account of customers.
