VACANT POSTS OF WOMEN DISABLED IN PSUS

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of handicapped persons and women recruited in the Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) during the last three years including the current year;
- (b) the number of posts reserved for the women/disabled in PSUs;
- (c) the time since these posts have been lying vacant;
- (d) the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to fill up these vacancies?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

(a) to (e): Recruitment to all posts below the Board level in Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) including the posts reserved for physically challenged persons as per the reservation policy in vogue for persons with disabilities is done by the management of respective CPSEs. There is no reservation for women in CPSEs. Targets for recruitment of employees in CPSEs in a particular year are decided by the management of respective CPSEs as per their manpower requirement, keeping in view the policy on reservation in vogue for SCs/STs/OBCs and persons with disabilities.

Information with regard to number of physically challenged persons as well as women recruited in various CPSEs is not maintained centrally in Department of Public Enterprises. Monitoring the progress of compliance rests with the concerned administrative Ministries.
