- (a) whether a number of Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) of Central Government in Madhya Pradesh has been closed down;
- (b) if so, the reasons for their closure;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any decision to set up new industries in the State; and
- (d) if so, the name of the agency through which these industries would be set up?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES & PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

- (a): As per Public Enterprises Surveys for the years 2008-09, 2009-10 and 2010-11, that were laid in the Parliament during these years, no Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE), having its registered office in Madhya Pradesh, has been closed down.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) & (d): The concerned administrative Ministries / Departments (including the CPSEs under their control) take the initiative to set up new industries / CPSEs. Setting up of CPSEs in different regions and in different sectors is based on techno-economic considerations.
