- (a) & (b) Eco-Tourism is one of the emerging segments of tourism in India. The Ministry of Tourism extends Central Financial Assistance to various State Governments/Union Territory Administrations for eco tourism projects on the basis of proposals received from them subject to adherence of scheme guidelines, availability of funds and inter-se priority. The Ministry of Tourism has been promoting Eco Tourism, inter alia through its domestic and international campaigns. The Ministry of Tourism also supports seminars and events focusing on development of eco-tourism from time to time.
- (c) & (d): The details of projects sanctioned to various State Governments/Union Territory Administrations which primarily focus on development of eco-tourism during the last three years and current year up to January, 2013, utilization of funds released and completion status are given in Annexure.
