- (a)&(b) International Film Festival of India (IFFI) was held from 20th to 30th November, 2012 in Goa. Apart from showcasing the world cinema, IFFI showcases the culture of India as a whole through its Indian Panorama Section. Films produced in different languages from different regions compete for selection to Indian Panorama. The selection is done by a jury comprising of eminent film personalities.
- (c) The Indian Panorama films are showcased at various cities across the country by organising mini festivals in collaboration with various State Governments throughout the year.
