- (a) the eligibility criteria fixed for appointment of Vice-Chancellors in various Universities;
- (b) whether the Government has appointed any Vice-Chancellor in the Central University belonging to the SC/ST category;and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. SHASHI THAROOR)

(a) The University Grants Commission (UGC) has issued the Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010, wherein the eligibility criteria for appointment of Vice Chancellors of universities has been laid down. However the UGC has informed that in its 487th meeting held in July, 2012, certain amendments have been approved, which include dropping Clause 7.3.0 from the Regulations.
