- (c) 116 Government Hospitals have been funded. State-wise details of funds earmarked and funds allocated/released are as per list at Annexure-III.
- (d)&(e) The Ministry proposes to identify 70 more hospitals to develop Trauma care facilities during the 12th plan subject to financial allocations. The list will be finalized in consultation with the State Governments as per provisions of the Scheme. Letter has accordingly been written to all the States for sending the list of hospitals to be identified for development of trauma care facilities during the 12th plan.
