(a) to (c): Proposals in respect of legislative changes in direct tax laws can be considered through the Finance Bill during the Annual Budgetary exercise. The Budgetary exercise for the year 2013-14 is under progress. The response of the Government in this regard shall be reflected in the form of Finance Bill. However, there is no change in direct tax laws with respect to fixed deposits which have been made in the last three years.
