(a) to (c) Government have seen reports that Chinese companies are involved in the construction of the Colombo South Container Terminal and Hambantota Port project in Sri Lanka on commercial basis. Recently, management of operations of Gwadar Port have been taken over by a Chinese firm. Government keeps a constant watch on all developments having a bearing on India's security and takes all necessary measures to safeguard it.
