Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of construction of two-lane alternate route between Barak Valley (Silchar) to Nellie near Guwahati-via-Harangajao Turuk covering a length of 244.235km;
- (b) whether any meeting has been held recently in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details and outcome thereof; and
- (d) the time by which the said construction work is likely to be completed?

- (a) The proposal for construction of two-lane alternate route between Barak Valley (Silchar) to Nellie near Guwahati via Harangajao Turuk was included under Phase 'B' of the Special Accelerated Road Development Programme for North East (SARDP-NE), which has been approved for preparation of DPR only by the Government. The preparation of DPR for the road has been completed by Assam PWD.

- (d)The Government has not yet given approval for implementation of the project and it is too early to indicate the likely date of completion.
