- (b) whether CAPART has not been able to associate with PRIs; and

(a)to(c) CAPART is an autonomous body under the aegis of Ministry of Rural Development. The objectives of CAPART includes encouragement, promotion of and assistance to voluntary action, strengthening and promotion of voluntary efforts in rural development. CAPART though associated with the rural development activities, does not have any coordination with the Panchayati Raj Institutions directly, as it has mainly been dealing directly with the Non-Government Organisations and Voluntary Organisations.
