(a) & (b) The estimated demand for petrol, diesel and gas by 2016-17 i.e. by end of 12th Five Year Plan against the actual consumption in 2011-12 is as follows:

- 1. Petrol (Million 14.992 22.588 Metric Tonne)
- 2. Diesel (Million 64.762 81.599 Metric Tonne)
- 3. Natural Gas (Billion 46.482 172.630 Cubic Metre)
