MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. K. CHIRANJEEVI)

(a) to (c): No, Madam. Ministry of Tourism does not have any scheme for according special tourism status to States/Union Territories.

However, Ministry of Tourism (MOT) provides Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for tourism projects to various State Governments and Union Territory Administrations prioritized in consultation with them, as per the Scheme Guidelines, inter-se priority and subject to availability of funds.
