(a) to (c): JNNURM is a reform driven Urban Infrastructure Program for provisioning of Urban Infrastructure and services in Urban areas, started by the Govt. of India in 2005. The Small and Medium Towns of all States and UTs are covered under the Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT), a sub-component of JNNURM, while there are 65 large "Mission" Cities. Water Supply, Sewerage, Drainage, Solid Waste Management sectors in the small, medium and other towns, as recommended by the State Govt., are admissible components. Sanction of projects is also dependent upon the funds availability and technical appraisal of the project. The details and present status of the projects sanctioned for Chattisgarh, Jharkhand and Uttrakhand States under the UIDSSMT are enclosed at Annexure.
