(a) & (b) The files relating to Justice Mukherjee Commission and Khosla Commission on 'alleged disappearance of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose' have been transferred by this Ministry to National Archives of India on 1st October, 2012 for permanent retention. National Archives of India has informed that the work of verifying items transferred by Ministry of Home Affairs is in progress. The files are likely to be made public after arrangement and accession of records.
