Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has done away with the current two month mandatory gap for foreigners holding long term multiple entry visa;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the preventive steps taken by the Government to ensure that this relaxation in visa rules/regime is not misused?

Answer

(a) to (c): The restriction of two-month gap between two visits to India on a Tourist Visa by the foreign nationals has been removed by the Government except in the case of nationals of Afghanistan, China, Iran, Pakistan, Iraq, Sudan, Maldives, foreigners of Pakistan origin and Stateless persons with a view to encourage tourism. With the implementation of the Mission Mode Project on Immigration, Visa and Foreigners Registration & Tracking (IVFRT), better monitoring of the visa issues and travel of foreign tourists has been facilitated.
