(d) the remedial measures taken/proposed to be taken by the Government including provision of modern security equipment/bullet proof jackets to the personnel of these forces?

Further, the government provides the CAPFs with weapons and modern security equipment through the Modernisation Plan(s). Budget is also made available to the CAPFs. They have also been delegated with financial powers to procure these equipment.
