## Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to introduce special schemes to promote horticulture products from North-Eastern Region in India:
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government also proposes to set up a fully export oriented Special Economic Zones (SEZs) in the North East exclusively for the growing horticultural sector;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether the manufacturers supplying goods to the SEZ units are eligible to claim excise rebate and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

## **Answer**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (DR. D. PURANDESWARI)

- (a) to (d): Special Economic Zones (SEZs) Act, 2005 and Rules framed there under do not specifically contain provisions for promotion of horticulture products in North-Eastern Region in India, however, Rule 5(2) of the SEZ Rules, 2006 prescribes a lower minimum land area requirement for setting up of a multi-product and a specific sector SEZ in Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Tripura, Himachal Pradesh, Uttaranchal, Sikkim, Jammu and Kashmir, Goa or in a Union Territory.
- (e): Yes Madam. The manufacturers supplying goods to the SEZ units are eligible for exemption of Central Excise duty as per provisions of SEZ Rules.
