(a) to (c) The Central Government has signed loan agreement with the Government of Japan for implementation of pollution abatement work for river Ganga in Varanasi city at a total cost of Rs 496.90 crores on a cost sharing basis of 85:15 between Centre and State. The pollution abatement works under the project include construction and rehabilitation of sewerage facilities and non-sewerage components including river front development such as improvement of ghats between Assi and Rajghat on the bank of river Ganga at Varanasi.
