(a) to (d) Facilities and way-side amenities like parking lots, eating places, toilet facilities, telephone booths, drinking water, first aid, petrol pumps, and rest rooms have been envisaged by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) to be provided on the project corridors. Details of already allotted sites for way-side amenities are placed at Annexure-I. Sites identified between Hyderabad-Kannyakumari on North South Corridors and between Porbandar-Lucknow on East West Corridors along with some tourist circuits are placed at Annexure-II. NHAI is contemplating to allot these wayside amenities through open bidding.
