- (a) to (c) The Central Government has constituted the National Ganga River Basin Authority (NGRBA) and has resolved under Clean Ganga Mission that by the year 2020, no untreated municipal sewage or industrial effluent will flow into the river Ganga.
- (d) The NGRBA was constituted in February 2009 and since its inception three meetings have been held on 5.10.2009, 01.11.2010 and 17.04.2012.
