- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) & (c): A contract has been signed with M/s HAL in March, 2010 for procurement of 12 surveillance aircrafts fitted with state of the art sensors, at a total contract cost of Rs.1102 Crore.
- (d) Six aircraft have already been delivered to ICG and the remaining six are scheduled for delivery by March, 2014.
