Modernisation of the Armed Forces is a continuous process based on threat perception, operational challenges, technological changes and available resources. The process is based on a 15 year Long Term Integrated Perspective Plan (LTIPP), five year Services Capital Acquisition Plan (SCAP) and Annual Acquisition Plan (AAP). The LTIPP 2012-27 and Twelfth Five Year Plan 2012-17 for the Armed Forces have been approved by Defence Acquisition Council.

2. The budget estimates (BE), revised estimates (RE) and the actual expenditure on Capital acquisition for modernization of Indian Army for the last five years is as under:
