THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI HARISH RAWAT)

(a) & (b) Article 262 of the Constitution of India and the Inter State River Water Disputes Act, 1956, amended in 2002, stipulate the process for resolving inter-State water disputes. There is no proposal at present to bring out a National Policy to solve interstate water disputes.
