(f)if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): Although there is no proposal for providing alternative livelihood to the beedi workers, vocational training is being imparted to beedi workers/wards under Modular Employable Skills Scheme in 308 courses through ITIs, NGOs in different trade.

(d) to (f): Beedi workers are issued Identity Cards for providing assistance under various welfare schemes and these cards are issued only to the workers who are above 18 years.
