(a) to (e) Government is aware of the whereabouts of some precious artifacts and objects like the Kohinoor diamond. Government has been in touch over the years with concerned authorities in the British Government through our High Commission in London on this matter. The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has informed that such items are not covered under the UNESCO Convention 1972 dealing with the restitution of cultural property.
