- (a): Yes, Madam. The work of Indore- Dahod has been started.
- (b): The work has already been taken up on part length between Dahod-Katwara & Sagore-Indore(49.72 km). The land acquisition and bridge works have been taken up.
- (c) &(d) : The work would be completed as per availability of resources. The total fund likely to be spent on this project is Rs. 948.80 crore as per the present estimates.
