A Memorandum of Understanding for sharing of Yamuna water up to and including Okhla is already signed in 1994 by the Chief Ministers of Upper Yamuna basin States of Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, NCT of Delhi and Haryana.
