(b) During the year 2011-12, under NPYAD a Grant-in-aid of Rs. 19,86,000/- to S.P. Memorial Shiksha Niketan Samiti, Assam has been released. Besides this, Rs. 90,00,000/- has also been released under NPYAD to State Govt. of Assam.

(c to e): The performance of the programme implementing agencies is monitored/assessed on the basis of their performance reports and inspection report of the recommending authority. Some of the programmes are also monitored by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan and NSS.
