(a) At present, the total network of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) pipelines in the country is 2316 Km, the breakup of which is given below:

1. Jamnagar-Loni Pipeline, GAIL 2.5 1,415

2. Vizag-Secunderabad Pipeline, GAIL 1.3 623

4. Panipat-Jalandhar Pipeline, IOCL 0.480 274

During the year 2011-12, around 3.95 MMT LPG was transported through these pipelines.
