- (a)&(b): The Central Government, with a view to ensure adequate supply of levy sugar for allotment to States/UTs., has increased the levy obligation on sugar factories from 10% to 20% for the current sugar season 2009-2010 (October-September).
- (c): In the current sugar season, the levy sugar quota to all the States/UTs. including Andhra Pradesh (except Bihar) has been allocated as per the quota fixed by the Central Government w.e.f. 01.02.2001.
