(a)to(c): The Ministry of Rural Development receives proposals from the State Governments and UT Administrations, District Rural Development Agencies (DRDAs) /Zilla Parishads for central assistance under rural development programmes. Such proposals are examined as per the programme guidelines and check list. The incomplete proposals are returned to the concerned State Government and the proposals complete in all respect are approved by the projects sanctioning/approval committees constituted in the Ministry. No proposal complete in all respect is kept pending with the Ministry including that from Uttar Pradesh.
