- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) Some Railways have produced small quantities of bio-fuel by using waste vegetable oil collected from hotels. The bio-fuel produced is being blended with HSD oil and is used for shunting locos, Diesel Electric Multiple Units (DEMUs), light duty road vehicles in Railway workshops etc.
- (c) In the last three years approximately 1,40,000 liters of bio-fuel has been produced.
- (d) A project has been sanctioned for setting up in-house facilities for manufacture of bio-diesel.
