(a) to (b) Govt. has drafted a National Chemical Policy 2012 with the objectives of growth and development of chemical sector in a holistic, integrated and sustainable manner, with manifold aims, mainly to increase the production of chemical sector by ensuring feedstock availability, attracting investments for capacity additions, providing quality infrastructure as well as promotion of R&D with focus on sustainability and green technologies.

The policy envisages funding of chemical innovations to promote green chemistry.

(c) The draft policy has been posted on the website of the Department and comments of the stakeholders are being processed. After finalization of the draft policy, the same will be submitted to the competent authority for approval.
