STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.2302 BY SHRIMATI BHAVANA GAWALI PATIL TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 03-12-2009 REGARDING RAILWAY PROJECTS FOR MAHARASHTRA.

(a) to (c): No proposal has been received from the State Government of Maharashtra regarding upgradation of railway stations. However, the State Government of Maharashtra has sponsored seven (7) nos. of proposals for construction of road over bridges and nineteen (19) nos. of proposals for skywalks in Mumbai area during current year, details of which are given in the Appendix.

Whereas proposals for road over bridges are being chased for feasibility at site, the proposals for skywalks, duly approved by Railways, are being taken up by Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA) for further action.
