(a) to (d) Yes Sir, the project proposal was submitted to the Planning Commission by the Ministry of Railways for according 'inprinciple' approval. However, keeping in view the huge shelf of on-going new line works which have not been completed on account of resource constraints, the Planning Commission had returned project proposals, including the above proposal, seeking clarification on prioritization and committed sources of funding. Hence, the project proposal is no longer pending with the Planning Commission.
