(a) and (b) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). The development and maintenance of NHs is a continuous process. Accordingly, proposals for development of NHs inter-alia including two-lane roads into four/six-lane received from the States every year are sanctioned keeping in view the availability of resources, existing liabilities and inter-se priority.
